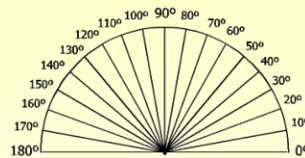


Maths:

Let's Draw, Measure and Answer

We have been learning about angles since last week.

There are four kinds of angles we are learning about which are the right angle which is 90° , obtuse angle which is more than 90° and less than 180° , acute angle which is less than 90° , and the reflex angle which is greater than a 180° . We've started with angles in a quadrilaterals which is a shape with four angles and four sides. We had to draw 2 quadrilaterals, measure the angles and add the four angles together.

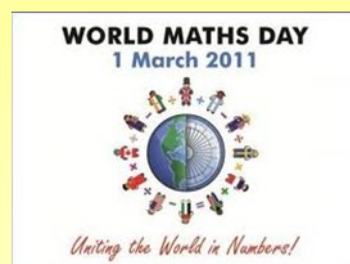
