

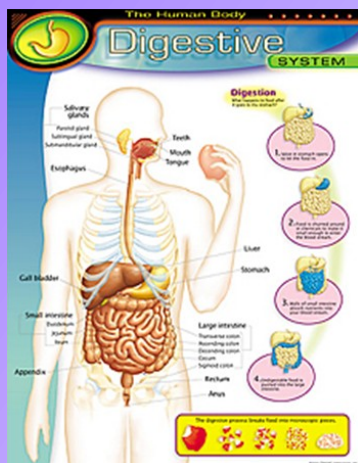

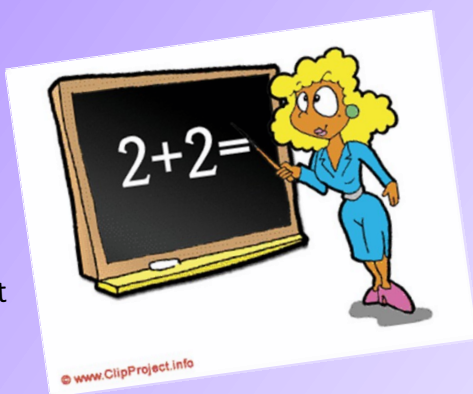
Language:

Next week in music we are doing a show for the parents and in the hall they well put some food for the parents.

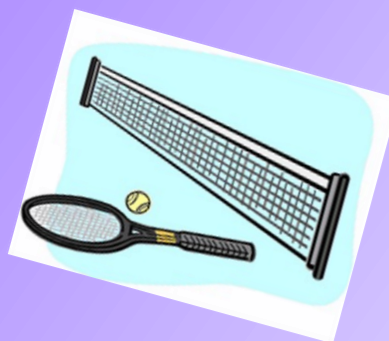
