The project with the most votes and feasibility of being completed will be chosen by the group. Last year, the five mile walk took place across the world to promote peace. The walkers carried banners promoting religious tolerance and raised money from people that backed their fight for global peace an understanding. Teenagers from enemy countries walked together in neutral sites to promote peace.
