

iOS 5 Bulletin

PowerSync Cart for iPod (TL357LL/C)

The PowerSync Cart for iPod requires different steps for syncing with iPod touch devices running iOS 4 and iPod touch devices running iOS 5. This document explains the differences.



Task	iOS 4.0 to 4.3.5	iOS 5.0
Software Updates	To update iOS on your iPod touch devices, please connect each device directly to your Mac one at a time, open iTunes, and click “Update” on the Summary pane for that device.	
Syncing	<p>The PowerSync Cart for iPod supports syncing over USB for iOS 4 devices.</p> <p>Each device can be either ON or OFF.</p>	<p>The PowerSync Cart for iPod supports syncing over USB for iOS 5 devices.</p> <p>Each device must be turned OFF to enable syncing.</p>
Charging	To charge iPod touch devices, please start with the cart in the OFF position and the USB cable disconnected from the Mac. Connect your devices to the included dock connector cables in the cart drawers, then turn the Power switch of the cart to the ON position.	

As a courtesy reminder, here are the steps for syncing:

1. Turn off the cart.
2. Connect your iPod touch devices to the included dock connector cables in the cart drawers.
 - * **For iPod touch devices running iOS 5, be sure to turn off each device.**

3. Open iTunes on your Mac.
4. Connect the main USB cable from the cart to the Mac.
 - * Best practice is to sync one drawer at a time.
5. Turn on the cart.
6. Each iPod touch will turn on and should appear in iTunes.
 - * If one of your devices does not show up, simply reset the device.
