

Create An Island

Your assignment is to create an island. Of course, there are certain rules and regulations you will need to follow, but other than that, let your imagination go wild.

The following is a list of items that must be included on your island:

1. A **Name** for your island
2. A **Compass Rose**- to show cardinal directions
3. A **Symbols Legend**- to show what symbols on your map represent
4. A **Name for every feature** included on your map. For example, Lake Lowell, Hell's Canyon, etc. These names do not have to be related to each other; however, in a true cultural situation the names would be focused around a belief, a discoverer, or possibly a reflection of the geographical setting.
5. **All the names MUST BE PRINTED IN INK.** No pencil, No cursive. The names must be easy to read and see- **BE NEAT!**
6. The geographic and man-made **features should show a true picture** and must fit together.

For example,

- a. Rivers- flow from higher to lower ground and will have a source and a mouth.
- b. Mountains, hills, plains, and valleys fit together,
- c. Cities, airports, towns, bridges, etc. should be where they would logically be. (Use a real atlas as a model if you have any questions.)

Please put in latitude and longitude.

You must have at least five items from each of the following categories on your island. You can have additional, but the required features are first.

9. river
10. stream

Land Features

1. island
2. peninsula
3. cape
4. isthmus
5. archipelago
6. delta
7. mountains
8. hills
9. plain
10. valley

Man-made Features

1. cities or towns
2. dam
3. reservoir
4. highway
5. bridge
6. harbor
7. airport
8. farmland
9. canal
10. railroad
