A scholarly business e-resource of magazines, journals, indexes, and abstracts.



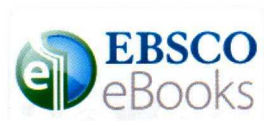
Middle Search Main Edition: Offers middle school students access to magazines, biographies, historical essays, and a database of photos, maps, and flags.



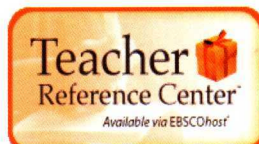
Kids Search: Easy-to-use search interface for grades K – 8 to browse age-appropriate magazine and news articles.
