Environmental Defense Fund	The Environmental Defense Fund is a non-governmental organization that focuses on the science behind Earth's environmental problems. Through research, direct action, and lobbying, the EDF works to improve the environment and the quality of life for all people. The Environmental Defense Fund uses donations for research, and to donate environmentally sound technology and to companies worldwide.	Global	The Environment	The majority of the EDF's financial resources go directly to their wide variety of projects. A donation to this non-governmental organization is used for a multitude of purposes that benefit wildlife, people, and the environment in general. EDF's focus on scientific research and its staff of renowned scientists with advanced degrees shows that the organization investigates the use of its funds extremely well. Recently this organization was able to lobby to pass an international resolution on penalties assessed when companies exceed their emissions quotas.	\$6,500,000
Network of East-West Women (NEWW)	NEWW is a world-wide organization that helps stop violence, and discrimination against women, promoting feminism and helping women in need. They provide counseling for women who need it for a variety of reasons, whether they have been through war, abuse, being in relationships with harmful things such as drug addicts or alcoholics, and helping them build up their own self esteem. NEWW also helps new female lawyers with their careers, building their confidence and helping them to succeed. NEWW make sure to advertise that women can support themselves financially, teaching them economic literacy, and getting women on their own two feet. In no way is this organization trying to pry women away from men, but rather to help them support themselves in a way that is healthy, to share in the relationship and not to be stuck in one.	Asia, Europe	Women's Rights	This organization does not blindly give away money to women, hoping it will help. NEWW gets to the bottom of things, giving women therapy and a financial education to help them permanently, not letting their husbands steal the money away. It gives women a choice and a say in their own lives, as well as women lawyers a step above the rest to help in the cause. Congress of Racial Equality (CORE)	The Congress of Racial Equality is a non-governmental organization that was at the forefront of the civil rights movement in the mid 1900s. CORE continues to work towards racial equality for people in the United States and worldwide. The Congress of Racial Equality is headquartered in New York, and has dozens of chapters throughout the United States, Canada, Latin America, Africa, Asia, and Europe. CORE promotes non-violent protest, and works to bring civil rights to all people throughout the world through non-violent methods.	North America, Latin America, Africa, Asia, Europe	Racial Equality	There are numerous other civil rights and racial equality organizations existing that could benefit from a large donation. The Congress of Racial Equality, however, was chosen because of the direct way it handles its funds. Other organizations do not directly itemize how their capital is spent, while CORE outlines its donor-funded projects and goals. First, CORE works to fund peaceful protests for worker reforms. Another major part of its funds go towards getting minority crime victims lawyers, and getting lawyers for those that may have been discriminated against because of their ethnicity during official proceedings.	\$6,500,000
AARAMBH	AARAMBH assists underprivileged children and women. They provide educational, health, and financial support. Children and Youth are given the following courses: Education, Vocational, Leadership, Health awareness, and Cultural Activities. This organization provides meals and scholarships for youth, and job training for Adult Women.	Navi Mumbai India	Poverty/ Economic Development	The goal of the AARAMBH is to provide educational support, motivate the parents of these children, and improve the communities in the slums. The AARAMBH sends 25 children to high school, and hope to expand it. They give scholarships to children for school, via donations. Thirty out of the ninety people who take the AARAMBH computer courses currently have a job and are capable of supporting their families. Presently, the AARAMBH has 10 community centers.	\$3,500,000
SOS Child Soldiers	SOS Child Soldiers have created and run 475 Child Solider Villages and 342 youth homes in 132 countries. These Villages and homes provide these former child soldiers with a new home and a family. These children grow up there until they are able to support themselves.	Global, Mainly Palestine, Rwanda, Uganda, Sudan	Child Soldiers/ Children's Rights	The SOS Child Soldiers is a prominent organization that helps over 70,000 children worldwide. In addition, the children are educated, trained, counseled, and nourished in many other ways. This organization gives these children the knowledge they will need to live a successful, happier life. Donations go towards sponsoring and protecting underprivileged and abused children.	\$5,000,000

Ontario Consultants on Religious Tolerance (ReligiousTolerance.org)	This organization has information on every religion and every branch of every religion. On their site they have over 4700 essays written by people about all topics that have anything to do with tolerance of religions. They say their main goals are to promote religious tolerance and freedom, describe religious faith in all their diversity, and to describe controversial topics from all viewpoints.	Global	Religious Tolerance	Religious Tolerance is an organization that is attempting to spread the word about all religions to show comparative religion. That is meant to help bring religious tolerance by understanding the basics of every religion. While the amount of direct action this organization takes is less than that of other NGOs, it is deserving of 2 million dollars in order to continue to advocate religious tolerance through its previously employed methods.	\$2,000,000
The International Campaign to End Genocide: Genocide Watch	This organization puts all information on their site about all the genocide and ethnic cleansing going on in the world today. The International Campaign to End Genocide's Genocide Watch sends representatives to countries to observe and report on genocides, much like Human Rights Watch monitors human rights violations in general. The monitoring and reporting of genocides help to stop those currently occurring, and to prevent those that may occur in the future.	Global	Genocide/ Ethnic Cleansing	This is an organization to help bring an end to genocide around the world by putting all information about all the genocides and ethnic cleansing around the world today on a website. The International Campaign to End Genocide uses its resources to bring awareness to these atrocities through global media pressure. Doing so puts pressure on the governments committing acts of genocide, helping to end genocide throughout the world.	\$7,000,000

Women Trafficking and Child Labor Education Foundation (WOTCLEF)	WOTCLEF provides Victim Assistance (reuniting the victims with their parents and giving them vocational training), primary, secondary, and tertiary education (including school fees, uniforms, etc). They also integrate various programs, such as education on HIV/AIDS and skill training for those who have been the victim of human trafficking and/or forced labor.	Africa, North America	Human Trafficking/ Forced Labor	WOTCLEF helps human trafficking victims both mentally and physically. Many of the victims who graduate from school have become doctors, lawyers, and skilled workers. WOTCLEF is a prominent advocate for the prevention of human trafficking, and are known for their awareness campaigns. 85% of its funding is directly given to programs and services to help the victims.	\$6,000,000
