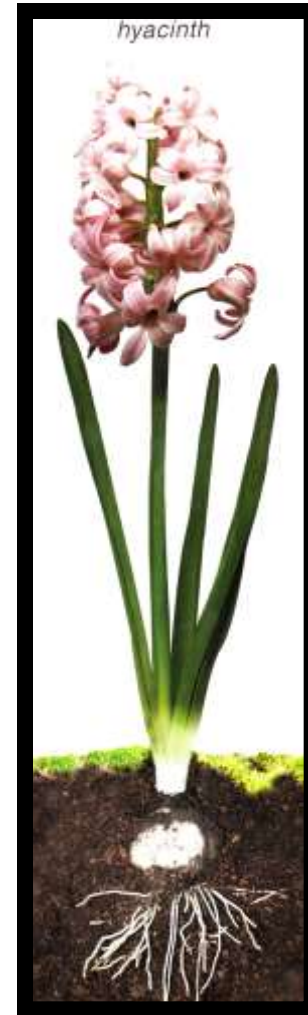

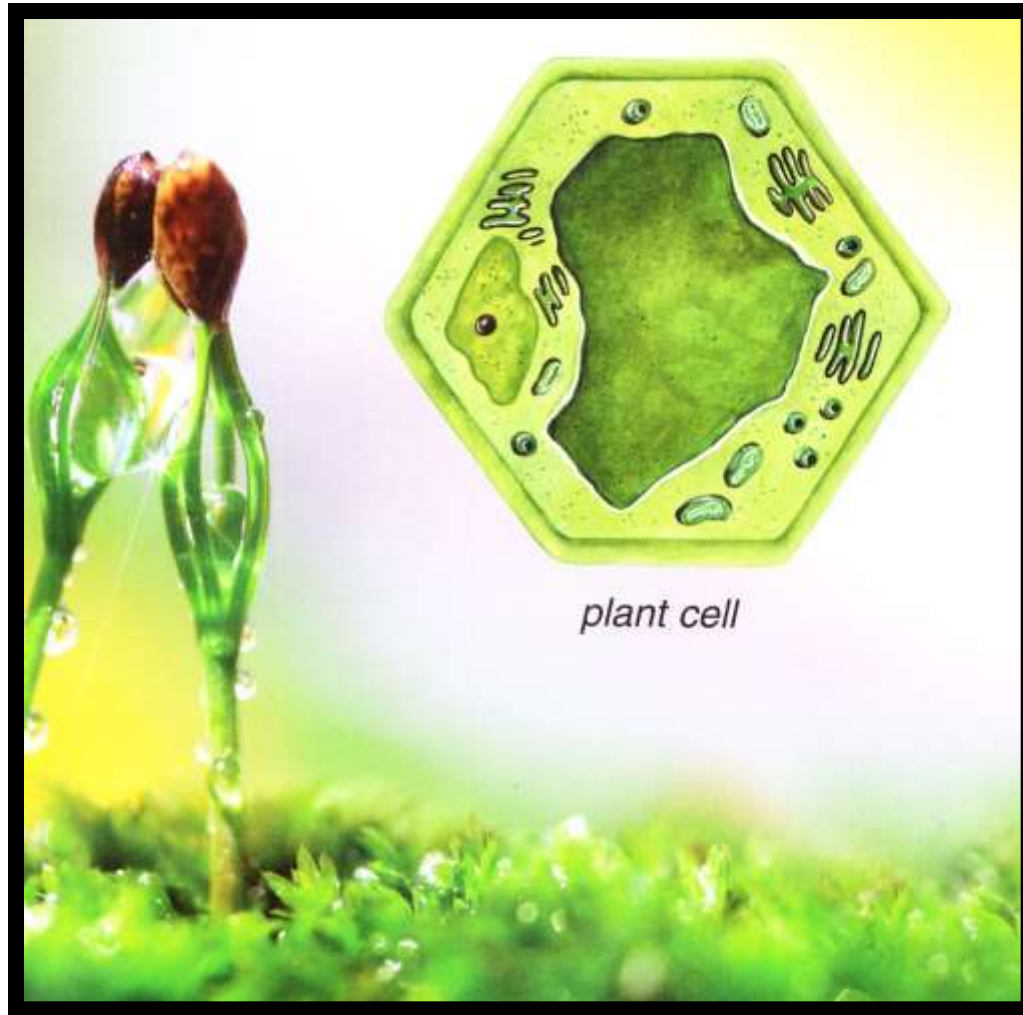


Plants need air, water, food and the  
**sun.**

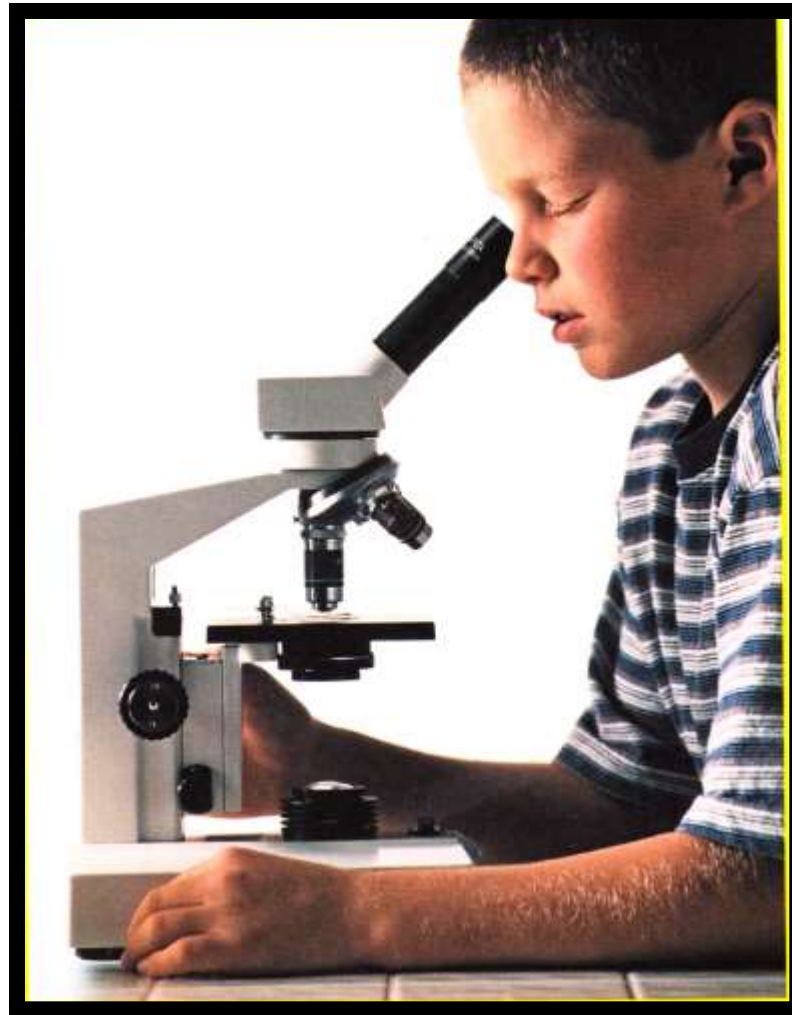




Plants can grow in water or **soil**.

**Trees** are the biggest plant.

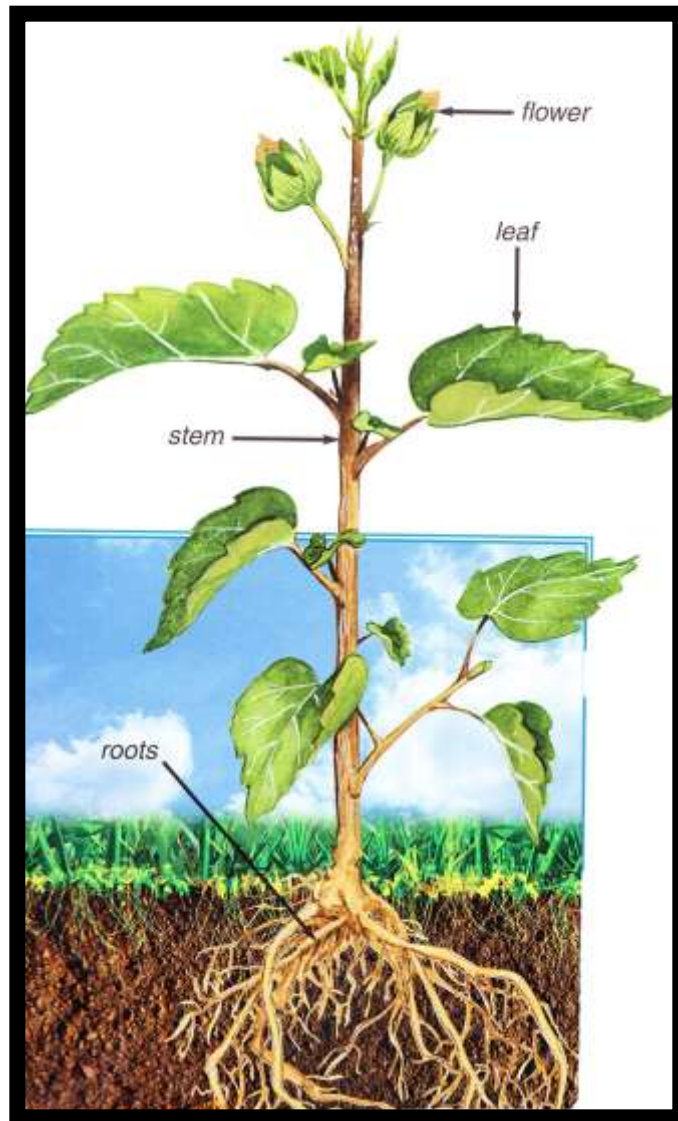


Plants grow and change. These tomato plants are **small** now, but they are growing quickly.

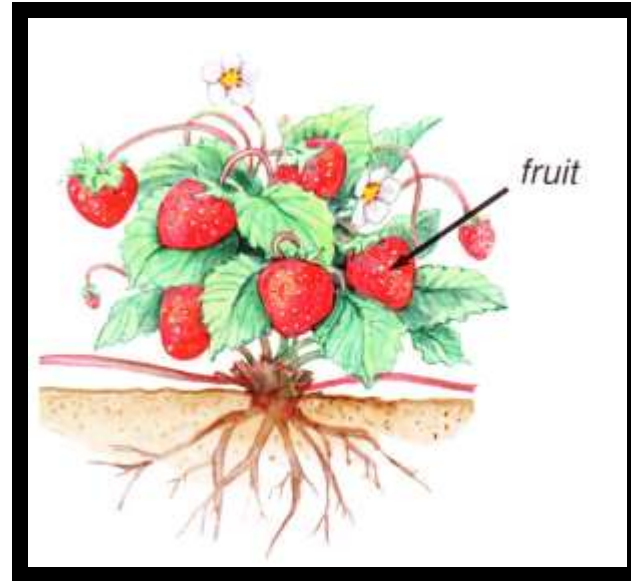


As tomatoes grow they get **big** and turn red.

Some plants have **flowers**. Some plants have fruit.

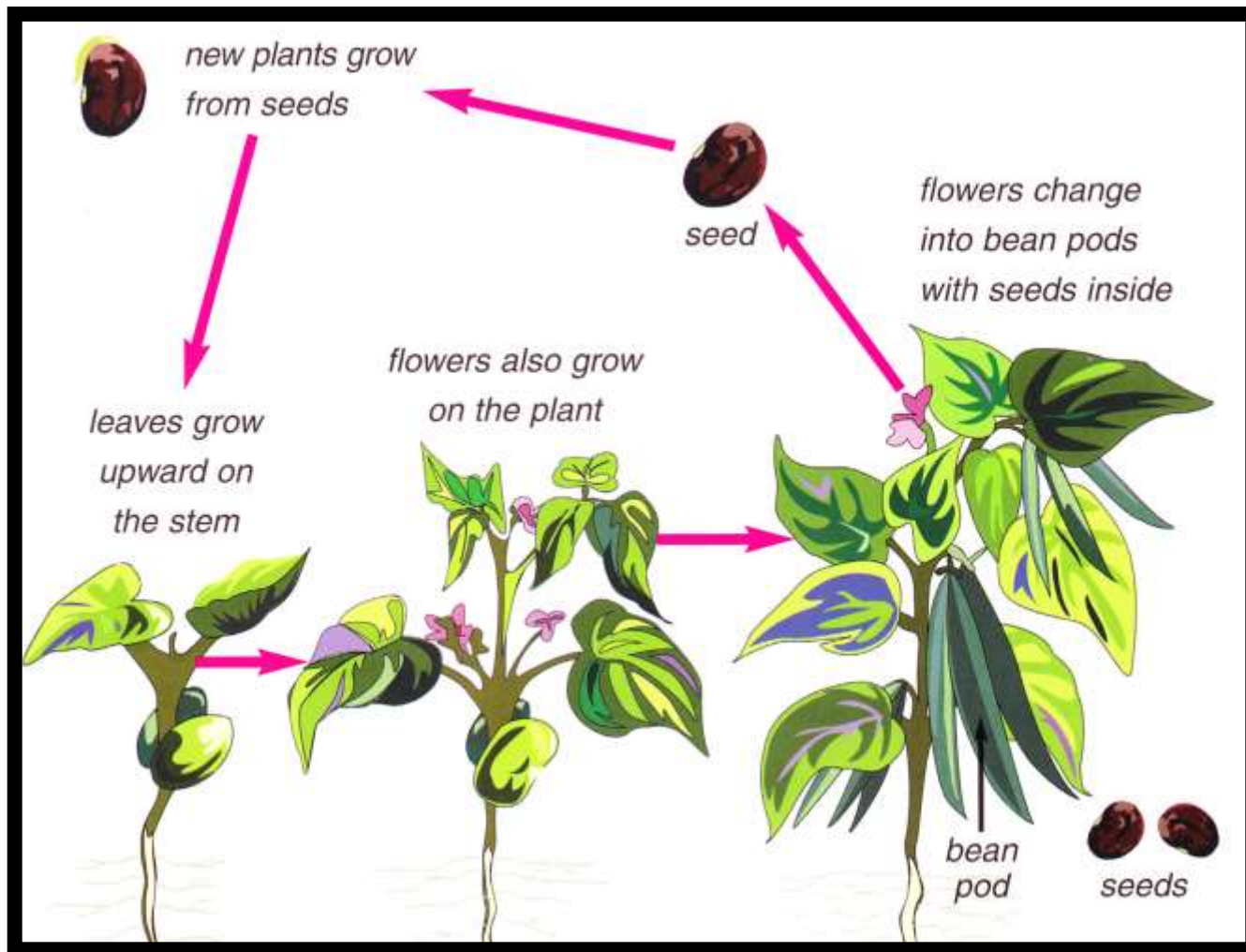


Plants have **seeds**.

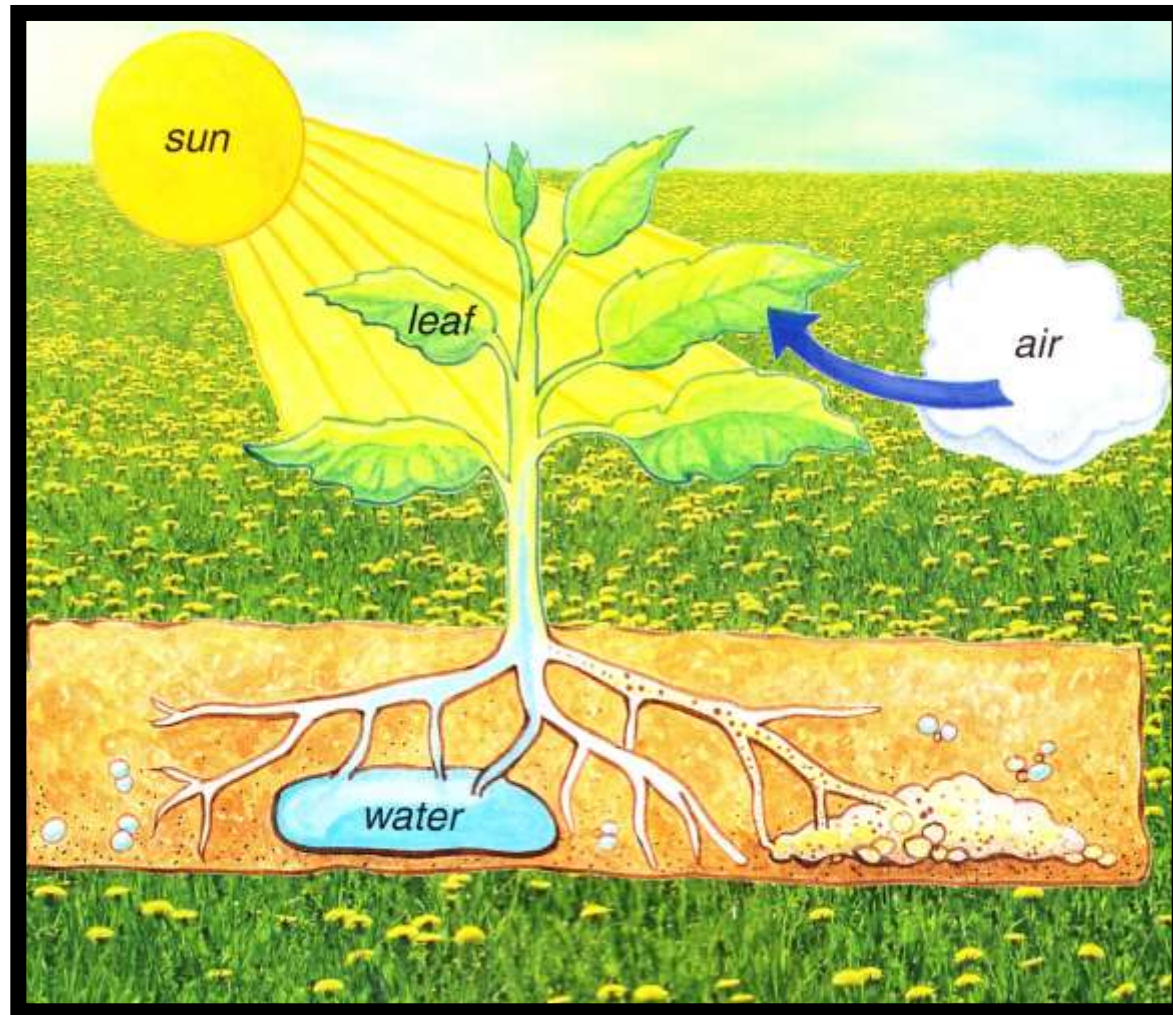




New plants **grow** from seeds.



The **life cycle** of a plant is how a plant changes from a seed to a plant.

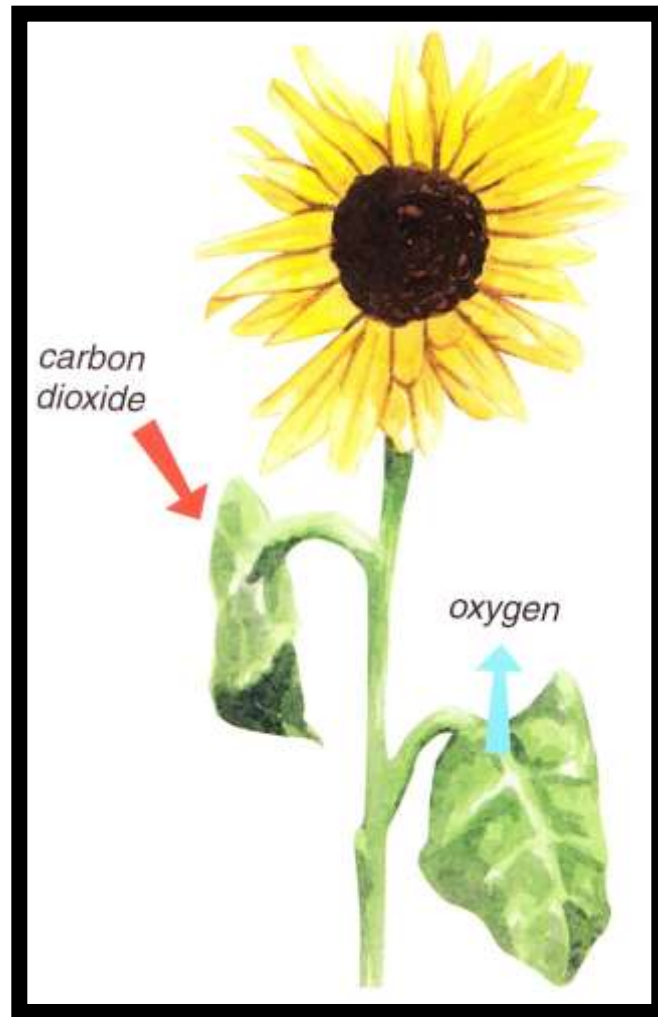


Plants make their own **food** from sunlight, air and water.
