

Pest Spray Activity 4

Herbicide

*NOTE: Herbicide is not a selective weed killer. It will kill any plant it touches so be very careful how you use it.

Equipment:

- cup measure
- salt
- vinegar
- bucket
- wooden spoon
- funnel
- wide mouthed jar
- label
- pen
- old pastry brush or small paint brush

What to do:

- Add a cup of common salt to a litre of vinegar in a bucket.
- Stir.
- After it's dissolved, use a funnel to pour into wide-mouthed jar.
- Make a label and stick it to the jar with name, purpose, date and instructions.
- To use: brush the herbicide directly onto weeds with an old pastry or paint brush.
