- Ⓒ Comma (Unnecessary), Using the Right Word, Comma (Other)

- Ⓒ Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Subject-Verb Agreement, Comma (Other)

- Ⓒ Semicolon, Comma (Other), Spelling

Pet iguanas like to sit in high places however it is still a suprise when one jumps onto your head.

- Ⓒ Run-On Sentence, Using the Right Word, Spelling

- Ⓒ Italics (Underlining), Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrase or Clause), Using the Right Word, Spelling
