

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are excited to announce our plans for this year's fall seventh grade trip. We will be going on a tour of Cleveland on Lolly the Trolley. It is an excellent opportunity for students to learn about the history and diversity of the region, along with making connections to various subject areas. Due to the large class size, we will be dividing the students into two groups. One group will be attending the trip on **Wednesday, October 21st** and the other group will be attending on **Friday, October 23rd**. Date will be determined by class size and schedule. Your child will be notified in the upcoming weeks as to which date they will be going on the field trip.

Students will be visiting four different ethnic markets: Gust Gallucci (Italian), Tink Holl (Asian), LaBorincana (Spanish), and the West Side Market. While visiting the markets, students will have the opportunity to purchase food items. In past years, five to ten dollars has been a sufficient amount of money to send with a child. As the trolley travels from place to place students can either eat the food they have purchased or bring a bagged lunch.

This trip will follow a regular school day schedule. Students will be back in time for their normal end of the day transportation.

Appropriate dress is required for this trip. Students should not wear athletic pants, shorts, or t-shirts with graphics. They may wear a sweatshirt or t-shirt with an Aurora or Greenmen logo.

On the days that students are not on the field trip, they will report to Harmon and follow a normal school day schedule.

We have been able to arrange a very complete educational experience for what we believe to be a reasonable cost. If family circumstances do not permit you to pay the entire cost, financial support is available. Please contact our guidance counselors Mrs. Biales and Mrs. Fecko for more information.
