The main purpose for this component is to place images and text on your site. You can also enter into categorized mode and use the page to show and store school newsletters, yearly field trip pictures, and many other interesting items.

For example:

A history teacher can create a categorized scrapbook and name it **History 101**. The teacher can then make a category for each lecture he or she taught, such as the **American Revolution-Boston Tea Party**. The teacher can then add an assignment to each lecture and attach the lecture outline to it. The Scrapbook component offers a way for parents and children to access assignments and review what was taught.
