

# Task Preparation

## The four topics:

- 1) Sexual health
- 2) Mental health
- 3) Drugs
- 4) Road Safety

## What to do:

Choose **one** of these topics.

Your essay is to be written as a response to the questions asked.

You should use your textbook for some hints as to some possible answers as well as research sites (use Australian sites only).

In all topics, you are to devise a strategy to eliminate or reduce the problem associated with this illness.

You will be required to prepare for this outcome in class and on the day you are able to bring in your information in order to write your essay up. ***You are not allowed to bring your textbook in with you.***

The more work you do at home in preparation, the more information you will have to use in this outcome!

The essay needs to be a minimum of 2 pages to be acceptable.

## ESSAY TOPICS

### ***Sexual health***

1. What are the main sexual issues for young people and how can they be managed?
2. Chlamydia is a key area of concern for young people. Why, and what can be or is being done to eliminate this problem?

### ***Mental Health***

1. What is mental health and give an insight to one area of concern?
2. Discuss an initiative/program targeted at young people in an area of mental disorders or diseases.

### ***Drugs***

1. Discuss a commonly used drug amongst young people and why it is of concern and what can be done about it.
2. Describe a drug campaign used in Australia that targets young people.

### ***Road Safety***

1. Discuss the issue of road safety and risk factors that may lead to this issue for young people.
2. Discuss an initiative/program targeted at young people in the area of road safety.
