




What Registered Nurses Do

Registered nurses (RNs) provide and coordinate patient care, educate patients and the public about diseases, prevention and health care, and provide advice and emotional support to patients and their family members.

Duties

Registered nurses typically do the following:

- Assess patients' medical histories and symptoms
- Administer patient medications and treatments
- Observe patients and record the observations
- Consult and collaborate with doctors and other healthcare professionals
- Coordinate and monitor medical treatments
- Help perform diagnostic tests and analyze the results
- Teach patients and their families how to manage diseases or injuries
- Report what to do in future after treatment
