

For this book club, you will be creating a locker lit advertisement for your book. You will be given a **legal sized sheet of paper**. *Anything additional you want to provide is fine.* All locker lit creations must be appropriate for display on the lockers in our school. Projects should be legible, and the writing should be error-free. Prizes will be awarded for best locker lit for both people's choice and teacher's choice. We might even open it up to the entire faculty to vote on them.

Please include:

- Book title, author, genre.
- Artwork that advertises the book, think bright, colorful, eye catching.
- A book blurb from you that captures your feelings about the book (one sentence that expresses your feelings about the book, with your name).
 - example: "Knocked my socks off with its beautiful language and compelling storytelling." - William Hetrick
- A significant quote from the book and who said it.
- Number of stars out of five (actually draw the stars and color in the number that corresponds to your recommendation of this book to others).
- BONUS OPPORTUNITY: If you include a picture of you reading your book aloud to someone with an explanation of who it is and where you were, you will receive 3 bonus points. Sharing the love of story is important! And you have to do it anyway for the readalong.

Note: When you give your book talk, you can either bring your locker lit to class and share it in your group OR you can take your book club group to your locker and share from there (MAYBE).

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
