WOTW 1: syntax (n.) - the ordering of words into meaningful verbal patterns such as phrases, clauses, and sentences.

WOTW 2: diction (n.) - an author's choice of words, phrases, sentence structures and figurative language, which combine to help create meaning and tone.

3. Journal ONE entry - write a half of a page on any related thoughts to the reading.

1. Write 1-2 short paragraphs on each of the concepts below (In Drive, in Period folder, Macbeth Folder [Name the document Your Name]):
2. Questions:
 - Did Macbeth's outcome (his death) happen because of his fate or because of his actions?
 - The witches prophesied his future, therefore knowing what would happen (fate)
 - His actions led to his future and his death (free will)
 - Does life have meaning? What is it? [you may google it to help yourself, if you need to]

Period 6:

1. Continue reading/viewing/discussing Tuesdays With Morrie.
2. With a partner, read aloud from 90-122. Complete a journal entry (your 4th) on anything from those pages. Due tomorrow.
