**WOTW 1:** argument/defense of a claim (n.) - the position or claim the author establishes. Arguments should be supported with valid evidence and reasoning and balanced by the inclusion of counter-arguments that illustrate opposing viewpoints.

**WOTW 2:** generalization (n.) - a conclusion drawn from specific information that is used to make a broad statement about a topic or person.
