**WOTW: diction (n) - word choice**

### Period 1, 3, 4, 7:

1. Finish taking notes on the background to the Anglo-Saxon Period (if necessary).
2. Read/listen to The Lord's Prayer in Old English (aka Anglo-Saxon).
3. Watch *Beowulf* movie trailer.
4. Begin reading the epic poem *Beowulf*.

### Period 6:

1. Finish reading Writing Assignment #2 aloud.

### Period 8:

1. Take the reading quiz on the Chapter 1 from *The Scarlet Letter*.
2. Discuss the beginning to *The Scarlet Letter*.
3. Check out/assign SAT Prep (8 quizzes) on Khan Academy. See College Board at (<https://www.khanacademy.org/sat>) or on my wikispace under SAT Prep (first link).
4. Finish reading Act 2 of *The Crucible*.
5. View movie to next act from the play.

### BOOK TALK ON JANUARY 6th:

1. Create a test for the book you read. DO NOT USE ANYONE ELSE'S TEST QUESTIONS! Include a variety of kinds of questions such as true/false (5), multiple choice (3), matching (5), fill-in the blank (2), 1 short answer, and 1 essay. Be creative, but you must have a total of 17 questions, one of which must be an essay. The essay question should be broad enough to require (at least) a two-paragraph answer. Be sure to write clear directions for each section.

2. Attach a completed answer key. (Do this by photocopying or printing out a second copy of the test and filling in your answers on the test, including the minimum requirements for a sample essay answer.) Your test should be typed. Do not plagiarize.
3. You will use this test as the guide to your Book Talk, which will be 7 minutes long on **January 6, 2016**. You will turn this in along with a completed rubric, graded by your peers. Total Value = 75 points
