5. Topics/Essays to be discussed/written:
 - Is Macbeth’s fate determined by destiny or free will?
 - Destiny - the events that will necessarily happen to a particular person or thing in the future; the hidden power believed to control what will happen in the future; fate.
 - Free will - the power of acting without the constraint of necessity or fate; the ability to act at one's own discretion.
 - Macbeth’s final commentary on life is contained in the bleak soliloquy “Tomorrow and tomorrow and tomorrow” speech.
 - Is this an accurate depiction of what life means?
 - How would support an argument for or against this view? And what is your view?
