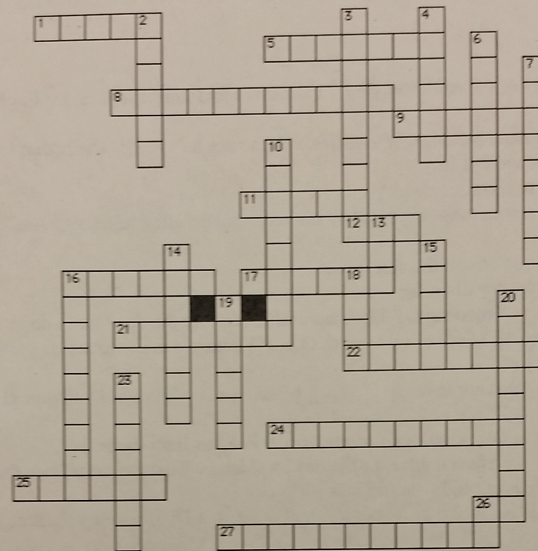


Macbeth - Dramatis Personae
