**WOTW 1:** dialect (n.) - a variety of a language distinct from the standard variety in pronunciation, grammar, or vocabulary.

**WOTW 2:** implicit/explicit (adj.) - implicit though unexpressed in the actual text, meaning that may be understood by the reader; implied.

**Period 1:**

    - Double space the entire paper.
    - Insert page numbers in the Header (like on my pdf examples).
    - 1 inch margins
    - Size 12 font, normal style
