Period 1, 3, 4, 7:

2. Assign groups for reading with tasks: 1. Read aloud. 2. Develop an author bio. 3. Analysis as to importance of the story. 4. Discuss/illustrate the use of the story's literary term(s). 5. Submit responses to questions that follow the story.
