WOTW 1: monologue/soliloquy (n.) - an extended speech spoken by one speaker, either to others or as if alone. - dramatic speech, revealing inner thoughts and feelings, spoken aloud by one character while alone on the stage.

WOTW 2: dialogue (n.) - conversation between characters or speakers in a literary work; in its most restricted sense, it refers specifically to the speech of characters in a drama.

Period 2, 4, 5, 7:

1. Finish grading the This I Believe essays and posters using the rubric.
2. Listen to a sample TED talk. Then listen to some in small groups on your own.
3. Hang the posters as we create the display.

Period 6:

1. Edit your This I Believe. You must have two readers.
2. Insert formatting:
 - Make your entire document 1.5 line spacing.
 - Make it a size 12 in either Arial or Times New Roman font.
3. Insert a Header that includes:
 - Single Space it.
 - Right Align it.
 - Your Name.
 - The Date (Feb. 14, 2018)
 - This I Believe
 - Center your title on first line of paper. Then hit Enter twice.
4. Begin audio recording, if far enough along. Use the Voice Recorder app.
 - Check for all of the qualities that would make it a well done reading:
 - Volume is loud enough
 - Enunciation is adequate
 - It's read at a nice pace (not too fast)
 - Background noise is non-existent or minimal
