Period 6:

1. You must have two readers who have read it, initial the back of your printed document which is set up like this:
 - o Insert formatting:
 - i. Make your entire document 1.5 line spacing.
 - ii. Make it a size 12 in either Arial or Times New Roman font.
 - o Insert a Header that includes:
 - i. Single Space it.
 - ii. Right Align it.
 - iii. Your Name.
 - iv. The Date (Feb. 14, 2018)
 - v. This I Believe
 - vi. Center your title on first line of paper. Then hit Enter twice.
2. Finish the audio recording. Use the Voice Recorder app. Convert to an mp3 and upload it to Drive and place it in our Drive "This I Believe" folder, titled as your name:
 - o Check for all of the qualities that would make it a well done reading:
 - i. Volume is loud enough
 - ii. Enunciation is adequate
 - iii. It's read at a nice pace (not too fast)
 - iv. Background noise is non-existent or minimal
