**WOTW 1:** dialect (n.) - a variety of a language distinct from the standard variety in pronunciation, grammar, or vocabulary.

**WOTW 2:** implicit/explicit (adj.): implicit- though unexpressed in the actual text, meaning that may be understood by the reader; implied; explicit - clearly expressed or fully stated in the actual text.

**WOTW 3:** point of view (n.) - the position of the narrator in relation to the story, as indicated by the narrator's outlook from which the events are depicted (e.g., first person, third person limited, third person omniscient, etc).

**Period 1:**

  8. Write Works Cited Page (6 sources in MLA format--easybib as a starter; 2 book reviews, 2 movie reviews, book and movie = 6 sources).
  9. Format for final version of paper
    - Delete everything before the paper.
    - Double space the entire paper.
    - Insert page numbers in the Header (like on my pdf examples).
    - 1 inch margins
    - Size 12 font, normal style
