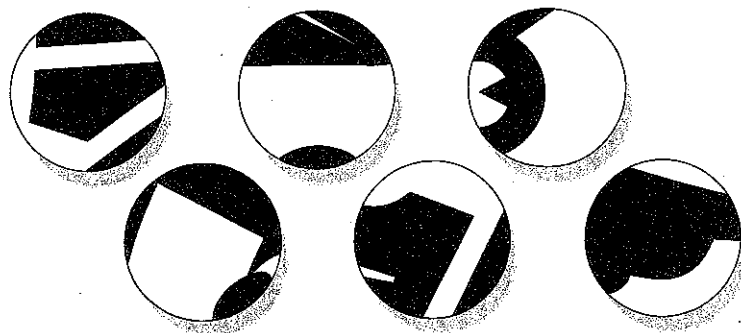
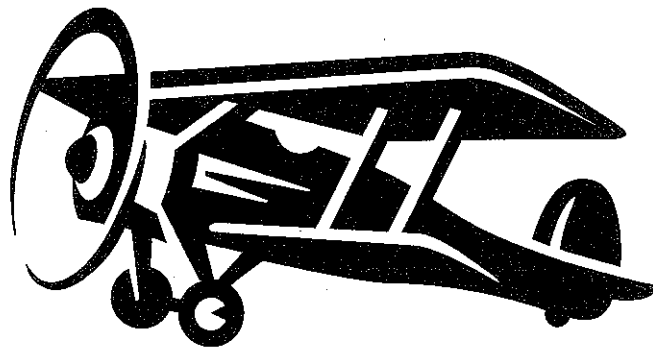
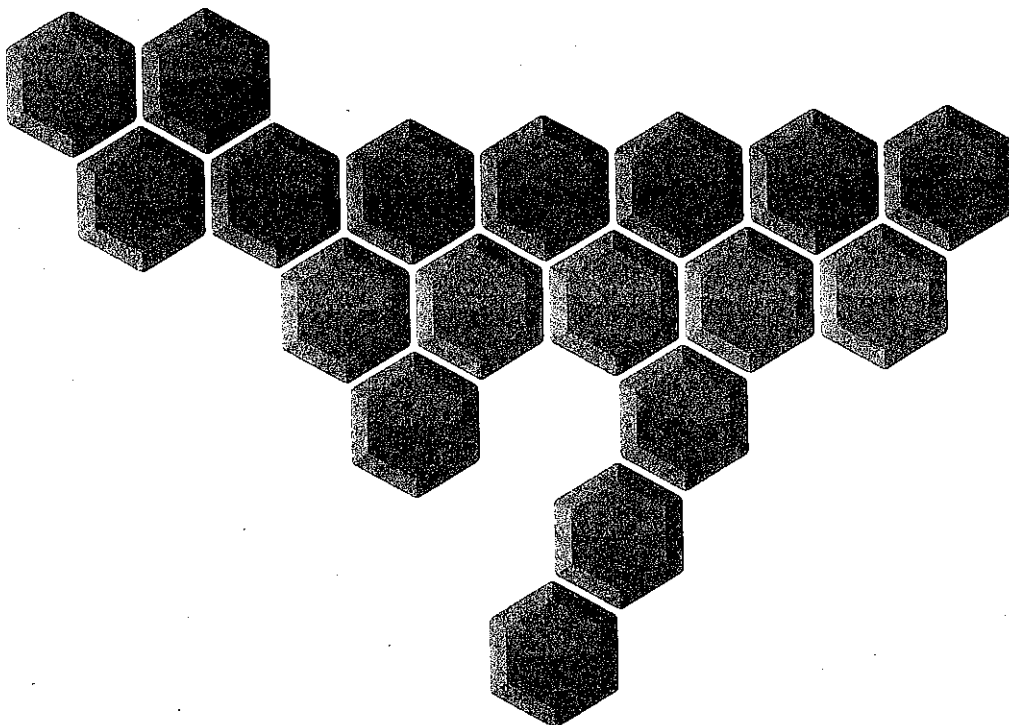

The six images in circles are closeups taken from the picture of the biplane above them.

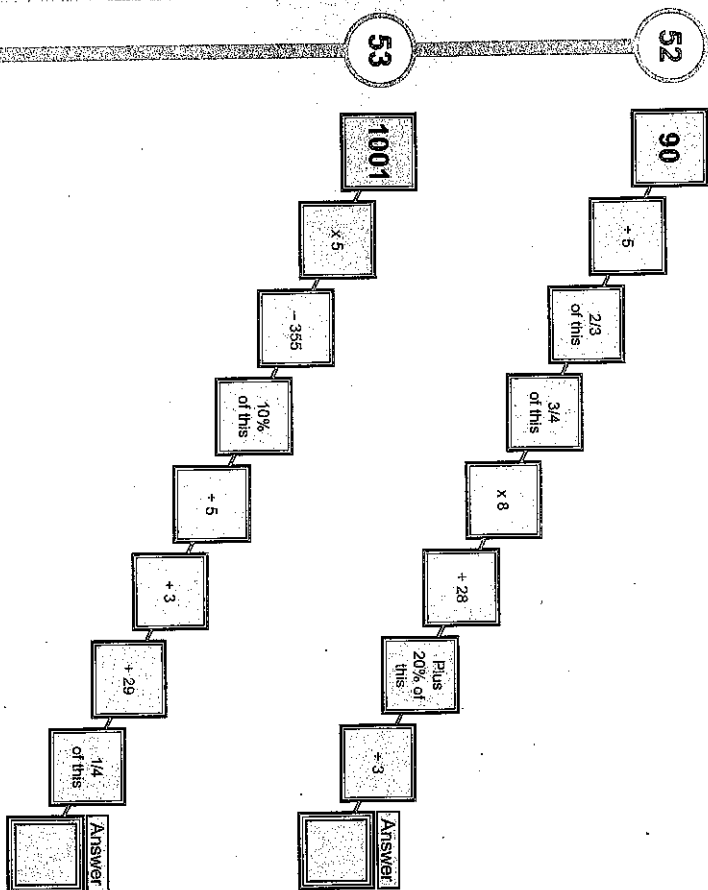
The closeups are right side up but 200% their original size. Can you find them in the original picture?

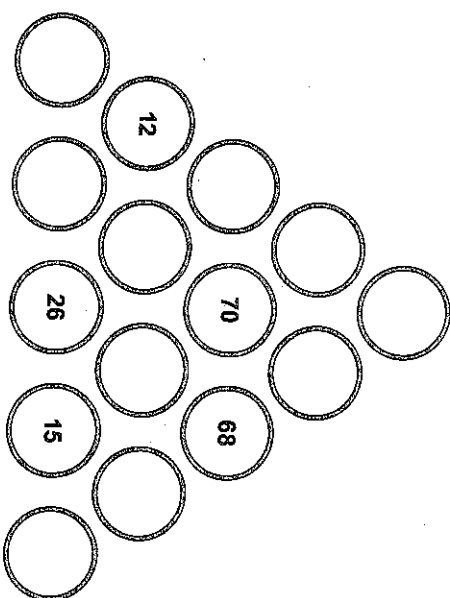
Starting at the top left with the number provided, work down from one box to another, applying the mathematical instructions to your running total.

Summing Up

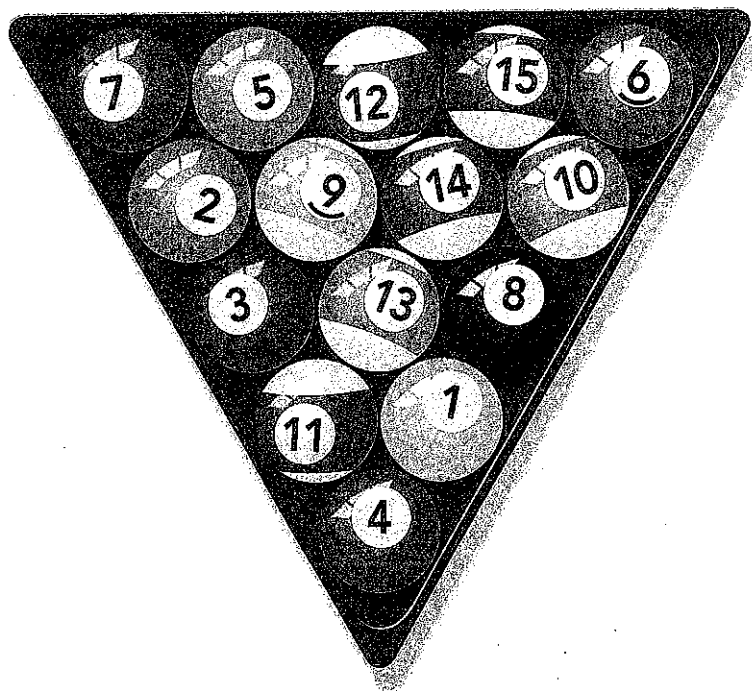

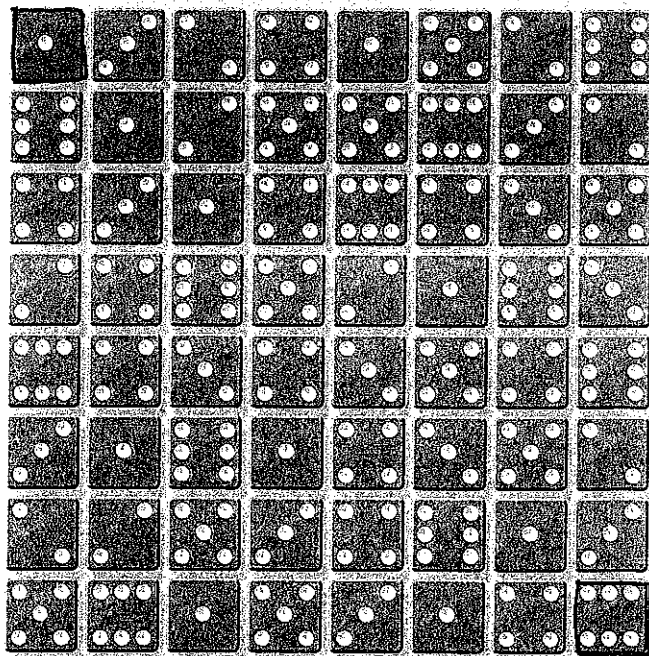
RACK YOUR BRAIN

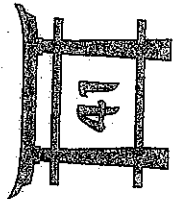

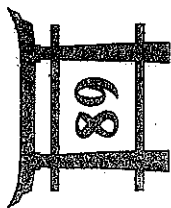

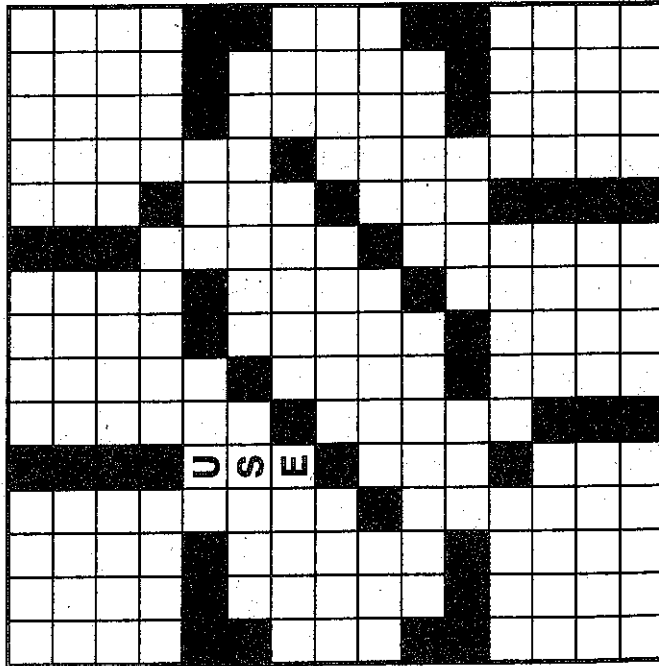
