## Newbery (Fiction or Non-Fiction)

Reading/Writing Connection – Choose 2 activities from this list.

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete the **MY OPINION** handout for your book. You may get this handout from your teacher or librarian.

\_\_\_\_\_ Create a TV commercial for your book to persuade your friends to read it. Write a one page script for this commercial including some of the techniques used to persuade. (Think of TV commercials you have seen.) Tell about interesting events and characters in the story. Tell about the award the book has won. Include the title and author and show the book.

\_\_\_\_\_ If this book is fiction, complete the **INVESTIGATION REPORTING** handout about the story.

\_\_\_\_\_ Give at least 2 reasons why you think this book deserves the award it received or tell at least 2 reasons why you think it does not deserve this award.

Technology Connection – Choose 1 activity from this list.

\_\_\_\_\_ Pretend this book is being made into a movie. Using Microsoft Word or KidPix, design a poster for advertising the movie. Use eye-catching color, fonts, and graphics.

\_\_\_\_\_ Videotape the commercial mentioned above.

\_\_\_\_\_ If this book is a Non-Fiction book, use **INSPIRATION** to create a Word Web. Select 5 new words from the book. Around each word, write the definition, a sentence from the book using the word, and your own original sentence using the word.
