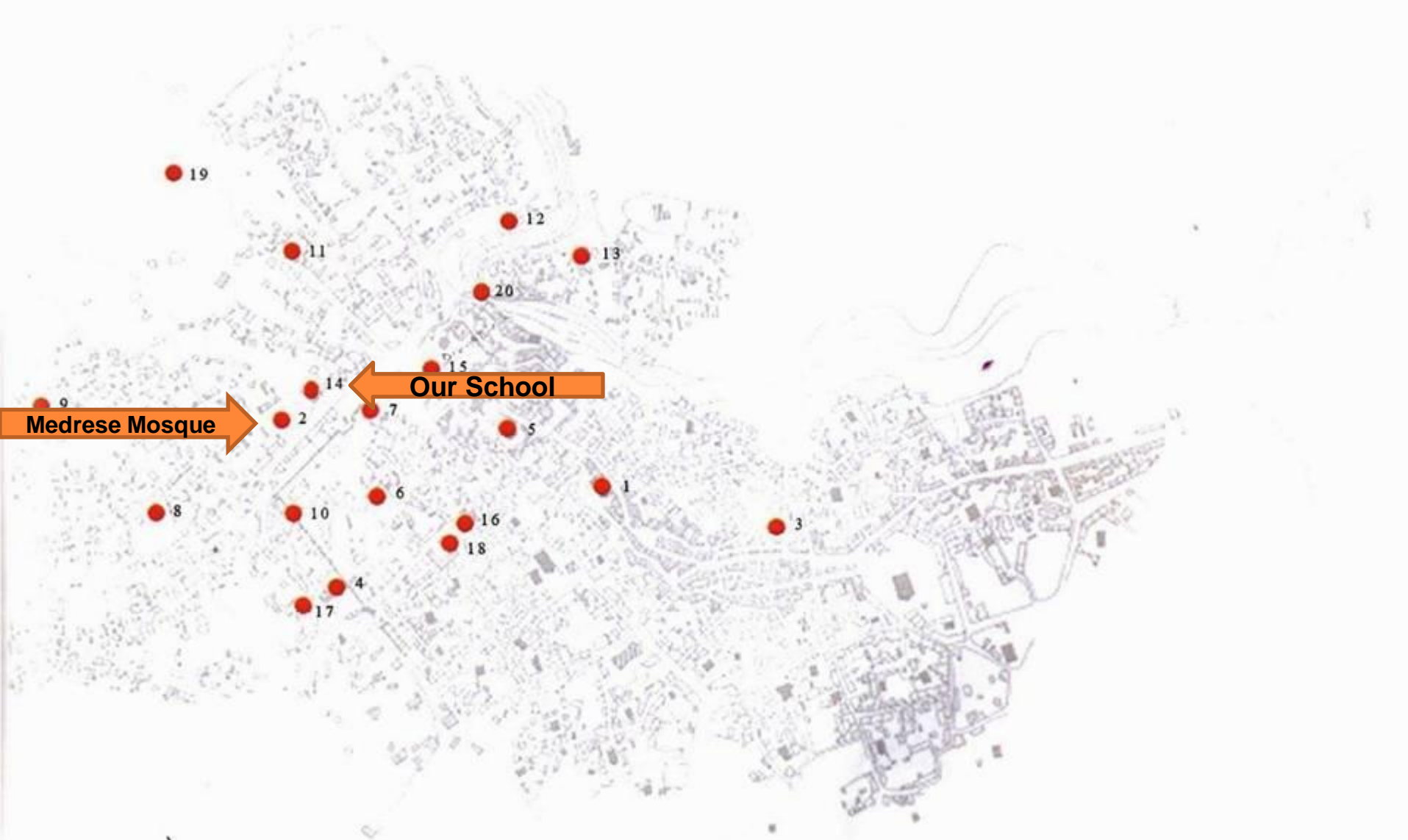

Between the marble stones of minaret, you can see two syllables of an ancient epigraph: ΒΩ... ΕΥΝ...

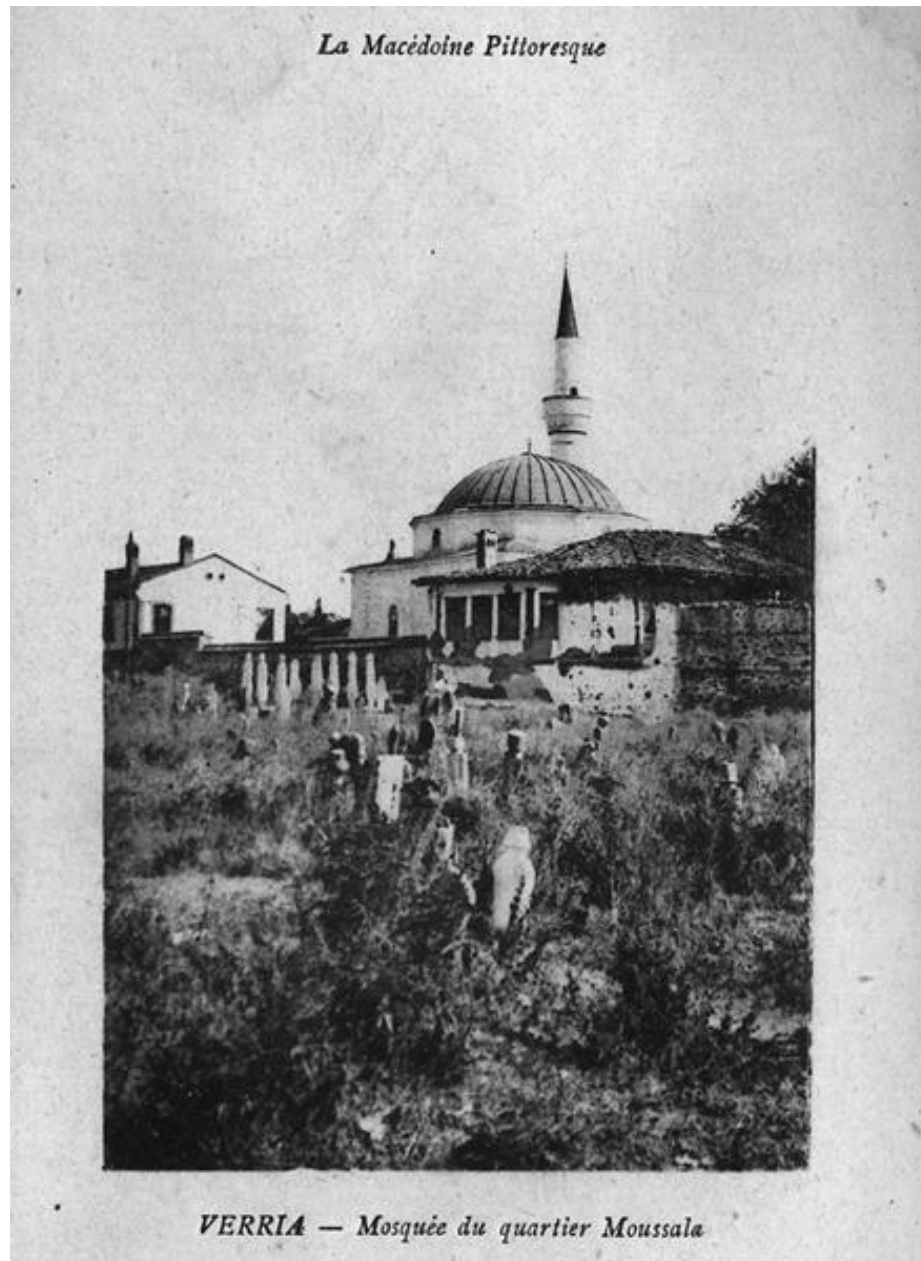

The main building

- Built with porous stones
- 10 m. high



The minaret

- 5 parts: base, big tower, balcony, small tower, top
- 20 m. high

The dome has authentic motifs like Koran's epigraphs, flowers and Islamic symbols
