

State-school

The State-school is a high school for young people. The State-school has been created in 1865 as a German school. It is placed on the superior corner in Sonderborg, together with the Courthouse and Town hall. In 1879 the school was taken over by the Prussian state. In 1910 the school became a high school with the name Königliche Oberrealschule zu Sonderburg. In 1911 the school building on Kongevej inaugurated. The building got signed by the architectural firm Jürgensen & Bachmann from Berlin. The german school was closed by reunification in 1920. The building got taken over by the Danish State and the new Danish settlement clusters.

The school both had a middle school and a real division, and since 1969 has also offered HF. In 1986 the school surpassed to Sønderjylland Amt, and that is why it changed its name to Sønderborg Gymnasium and HF. When it in 2007 surpassed to freehold, it got its own name back. The Sønderborg Gymnasium has been hit by pollution, it can be seen in the snail decorations which surrounds the frontdoor . Later on a new building was raised it offering a new education called HF.
