

Fifth Grade Rockin' Lock In!

It's hard to believe, but if you ask fifth graders what is the number one thing they want to do their last year at Holmes, they will say, "Stay all night at school!" So that's what we'll do in April. **On Friday, April 25**, students will check in at 8 p.m. outside the auditorium. They will learn about peace circles and participate in one, go through rotations where they will work on the fifth-grade art project, create items for a charity, compete in Jeopardy, play Minute to Win It, and much more. Pick up is promptly at 6 a.m. on Saturday. Students who do not wish to stay the night may be picked up at 11 p.m.

A parent must volunteer for a shift during the night in order to have their child attend. All parent volunteers will need a background check. If you are supervising during the sleeping shift from 2:45-5:15 a.m., you will need to go to the District 97 office for fingerprinting. This check requires several weeks. Some of you have already had this check completed for Outdoor Ed and may want to volunteer for the sleeping shift. All other volunteers simply need to provide a photocopy of your driver's license.

A parent must check their child in outside the auditorium the night of the Lock In and must come in and check their child out in the morning unless permission has been given below for another adult to pick up the student. Students should bring a sleeping bag and pillow for the mandatory rest time. A meal and a snack will be provided. **Cost is \$12.** Please contact your child's teacher if this fee is a hardship.

Please return the permission slip below with your signature, your child's signature, and the \$12 fee by Monday, April 7. Please be sure you have signed up for your volunteer shift. We will email a confirmation of your shift and a list of supplies your child will need.
