

# Fifth Grade Rockin' Lock In!

A parent must volunteer for a shift during the night in order to have their child attend. Pick up is promptly at 6 a.m. on Saturday. Students who do not wish to stay the night may be picked up at 11 p.m.

A parent must check their child in outside the auditorium the night of the Lock In and must come in and check their child out in the morning unless permission has been given below for another adult to pick up the student. Students should bring a sleeping bag and pillow for the mandatory rest time. A meal and a snack will be provided. Cost is \$10. Please contact your child's teacher if this fee is a hardship.
