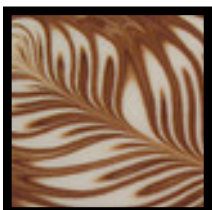

The Altura Northland Barista Championships will be held on the 15th & 16th of May 2011 at the Northland Salon Culinaire, NorthTec, Raumanga Valley Rd, Whangarei.

There are two classes in this competition – **Open** and **Trainee** (incorporating Secondary School Culinary entrants). Numbers are limited to **14** people per class.

Open Class will be held on Sunday 15th of May, 2011

Trainee Class will be held on Monday 16th of May, 2011

Prizes will be awarded for both classes as follows:

Open

1st Place – Espresso machine

2nd Place – Barista pack

Trainee

1st Place – Barista pack

2nd Place – Northland Hospitality voucher

Equipment:

Coffee machines, grinders and milk will be supplied. You may bring your own coffee beans otherwise beans will be supplied.

On confirmation of entry, a list of equipment you will be required to bring will be emailed to all entrants.

B. Each competitor will serve each of the four sensory judges a single espresso, a single cappuccino and a signature beverage of his/her choice (espresso-based and alcohol-free), for a total of twelve drinks, during a period of fifteen minutes.

For the purpose of this competition the Latte replaces the Signature coffee.
