### 6.01 Recognize architectural features quiz

1. \_\_\_\_\_ - one of the most popular residential styles. Simple and economical to build. Allows good ventilation. Can be very steep or low pitched, forms a triangle
2. \_\_\_\_\_ - one the most economical roofs to build. Not covered with traditional roofing materials
3. \_\_\_\_\_ - more complicated than gable roof. Provides a cornice/triangle on all four sides of the house. Ventilation is NOT good.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ - roof that has 2 slopes on all sides, with the lower slope being steep and the upper slope almost flat
5. \_\_\_\_\_ - often called a barn roof. Common with Dutch Colonial style. Permits headroom on top level of house.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ - boards with one edge thicker than the other laid in overlapping rows
7. \_\_\_\_\_ - structures projecting through a steeply sloping roof. Window set in this structure is called a "dormer window"
8. \_\_\_\_\_ - triangular or arched decoration, usually over a doorway
9. \_\_\_\_\_ - semicircular, round, or oval window with fan-shaped panes of glass, usually over a door
10. \_\_\_\_\_ - tall, open porch, supported by columns, over the front entrance
11. \_\_\_\_\_ - lacy-looking cutout wood trimming
12. \_\_\_\_\_ - decorative flattened columns that frame a door
