Step 1: Copy the sentences.

Step 2: Circle the noun (s)

Step 3: Underline the adjectives

Step 4: As you are reading the sentences to yourself, switch the adjectives. If switching the adjectives in your head doesn't change the meaning of the sentence, place a comma between the adjectives. If it does change the meaning of the sentence, don't place a comma between the adjectives.

2. **My favorite dessert is a hot fudge sundae.**
3. **The big red fire truck raced down the busy crowded highway.**
4. **My brother's favorite is Dutch apple pie.**
5. **My light blue house has dark blue shutters.**
6. **The smoky crackling fire roared through the old beautiful forests of Yosemite.**
