Bricklayers lay large white blocks.



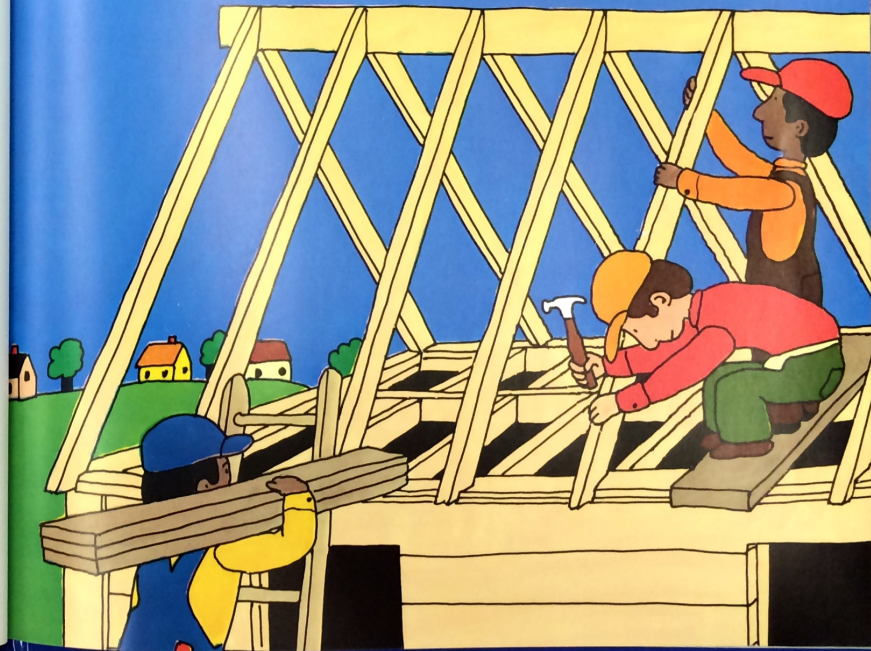
Carpenters come and make a wooden floor.



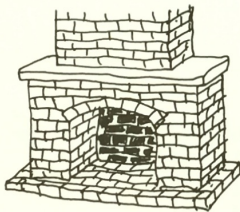
They put up walls.



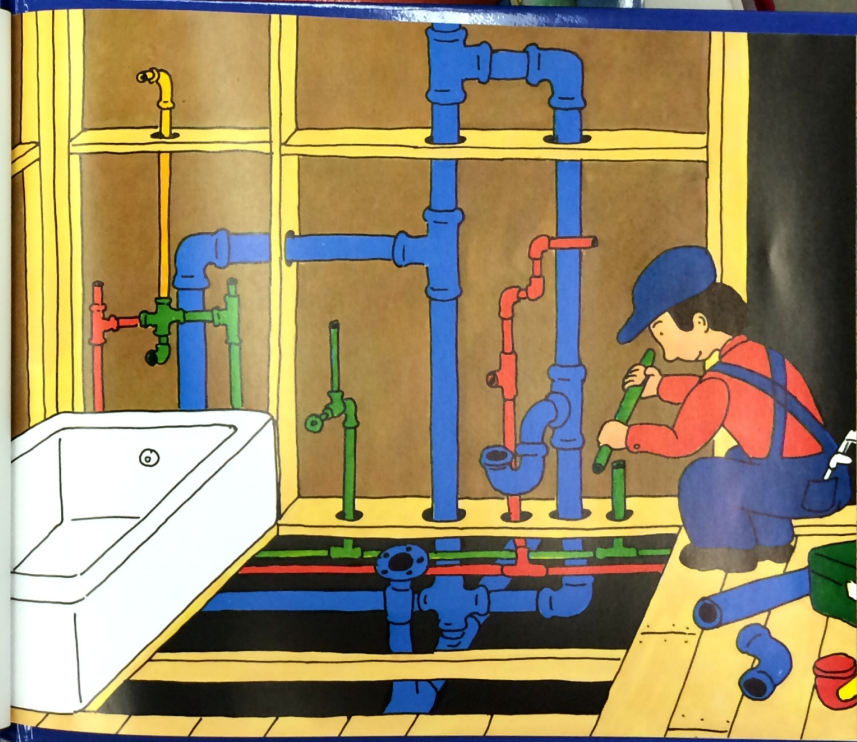
They build a roof.
