

Setting up Turnitin.com for Students

1. On your iPad, select Safari and go to Turnitin.com.
2. Immediately [Add to Home Screen] when the page opens and then reopen the newly made icon.
3. Select [Create Account]
4. Enter your school email address
5. For your password, enter your school ID# + hj (11111hj)
6. Select [Student]
7. [Submit]
8. Enter your Class ID #
2/3- 10299407
5/6- 10299415
7/8- 10299427
9. Enter your Class Enrollment Password
2/3- hyde23
5/6- hyde56
7/8- hyde78
10. Put in your first name and then last name
11. Leave the display name as it is
12. Put in your student email address again
13. Again, for your password, enter your school ID# + hj (11111hj)
14. Select a secret question and enter the answer
15. Agree to the user agreement
Now your account is made.

To use Turnitin features,
Students will need:

- a working school email address
- the Drive app (Google Drive)

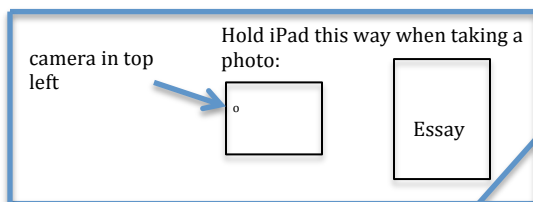
I already have a Turnitin.com account, but I need to enroll in a different teacher's class:

1. Log in to Turnitin.com
2. On your home page, select the 2nd tab at the top called "Enroll in a Class"
3. Enter your other teacher's "Class/section ID."
4. Enter your other teacher's "Enrollment password." (Remember that this is caps sensitive)
5. Press submit.

Submitting an Assignment

Submitting a Typed Essay

1. First, make sure your essay was typed in Docs and saved in Google Drive
2. From your homepage on Turnitin.com, select your class
3. Select Submit on the assignment you wish to turn in
4. You will see blue text at the top. It will say Cut & Paste Upload or Single File Upload. Select Single File Upload from this blue drop down menu.
5. Here, you have the option of submitting your essay in various ways. Put in the title of your assignment and then select Google Drive.
6. It might make you sign-in to Google Drive again- do it. You will then be able to select the assignment from your Google Drive immediately from within Turnitin.com.
7. Select the essay you wish to submit and then upload/submit it.
8. You will then get a receipt of your submission.
9. You may check back in your account at a later date to review your grade and comments



Saving a typed assignment to
your Google Drive:

- Save assignment to desktop
- Go to Google.com
- Sign in (top right) with your email and your ID# + hj
o 11111hj
- *If it is your 1st time using Drive, you will be asked to set up your account- do it.*
- Click on square dots in the top right hand corner.
- Select Drive.
- Push the upload button (looks like an arrow pointing up with a line underneath)
- Select Files
- Find your assignment from your desktop

Submitting a Hand Written Essay (iPad only)

1. Take a very careful and steady picture of your essay.
Make sure you capture the whole essay in the image and that every word can be read clearly. Edit, enhance, and crop the photo if needed and then save it in Photo.
2. Open the Drive app (Google Drive).
3. Select Uploads (+)
4. Select Upload Photos or Videos.
5. Select photo from Camera Roll. It will upload on its own.
6. Close Drive by pushing the Home button.
7. Log in to Turnitin.com through Safari or open it from your home screen if you put it there.
8. Follow steps 2-9 for Submitting a Typed Essay. *You might have to re-log-in to Google Drive and agree to give Turnitin.com permission to grab the photo (you should only have to do this the 1st time you submit an essay).* If you are already signed in to Google Drive, you will be able to select the assignment from your Google Drive immediately from within Turnitin.com.

You must have Drive enabled in Settings for this to work. If you get an error screen here, go to Settings; click on Privacy; click on Photos; slide Drive to green. If you had to do this step, you will need to do the italicized part in step 5.
