

Supplies Needed for Mrs. Hyde's 7th Grade ELAR

These items are not in addition to the school supply list available on the Henderson Middle School Website. This list tells you what items from that list are specifically for ELAR and what to do with them.

- **1 wide-ruled composition notebook** (Put your name on it and give it to me)
- **10 pack of markers** (give to me)

- **1 sturdy zippered pencil pouch or pencil box** (Put your name on it and give it to me with the following supplies zipped up inside of it. Be sure to write your child's name with a Sharpie on each of the following pieces before putting them in the pencil pouch:
 - - **Multiple colors of pens**
 - 2 should be red
 - others should be dark
 - - **Several pencils**
 - - **Small pencil sharpener**
 - - **3-4 multiple colors of highlighters**
 - - **1 big eraser**
 - - **12 map pencils**
