

Me Talk Like a Caveman

Let's get this straight: *I* designates the subject of the sentence; *me* designates the object. An easy way to figure out if *I* or *me* is correct is to remove the other person from the sentence, and then check to see if the sentence still makes sense. For example, *Me and Jaime went out last night*. That sounds fine in speech, but take away *Jaime*, and you're left with *Me went out last night*. That sounds wrong, so you know that *I*, not *me*, is correct.
