



An Honors student has adopted the Agency Needs Assessment as her legacy project for our Southern Leaders program, and has committed to revisiting agencies annually for updated reporting. She will establish a renewal protocol and will train a student assistant to take over as an Honors Internship in the following year. A second Honors Internship is being created in Community Engagement, and this student will spend one year attending all Advisory Board meetings and managing the project pipeline.

The Community Partner Needs Assessment is a partnership between the Office of Student Leadership and Civic Engagement (Student Affairs) and the Bureau of Business Research and Economic Development (BBRED) within the College of Business Administration with a secondary objective of providing aggregate data on the non-profit sector to support future grants and assess the utility of a proposed Center for Non-Profit Management within the College of Business Administration.
