1. Angle of the HuCom 2008 paper

Multi-angle view on preference elicitation for negotiation support systems (preliminary title)

- User-centered testing/evaluation (Main line: preference elicitation for NSS)
 - o Why? (separate)
 1. Mostly AI oriented research (first model, then interface), not user-centered → refs that show risks, problems about this approach
 2. HCI: how to extract preferences → refs: preference elicitation is difficult (recommender systems, rating (psychology), search engines (hyperbolic tree, tag clouds, aqua browser etc.))
 3. Preferences: cognitive & affective → refs: how to extract affect in an easy way
 - o Why? (together)
 1. Avoid sub-optimization in one of the areas (HCI, AI) → this paper
