**Alina:** writing paper about questionnaire data for CHI 2010 (deadline 17<sup>th</sup> of Sept), implementation of 4 different prototypes of preference elicitation interface, poster for D-CIS, HCI course assistance.

**Koen:** special issue for HUCOM 2008, waiting for STW announcement → mail to Onno.

**Dmytro:** writing thesis: one chapter left, will be journal article, 2 journal articles written about learning and analysis of nego strategies.; tournament → set up needs to be put online, maybe run first in-house, then at AAMAS.

**Catholijn:** proposal (deadline 8<sup>th</sup> of Oct) TBM: "Next generation infrastructures", How new policies are created in the Netherlands (horizontal regulation instead of vertical), multiparty negotiation with all the parties involved.
