



Vimeo App for video editing on the iPad

Vimeo is a free App that allows students to create, edit, and save video files to the iPad. Video can be taken using the camera App on the iPad or from within the Vimeo App.

IMPORTANT:

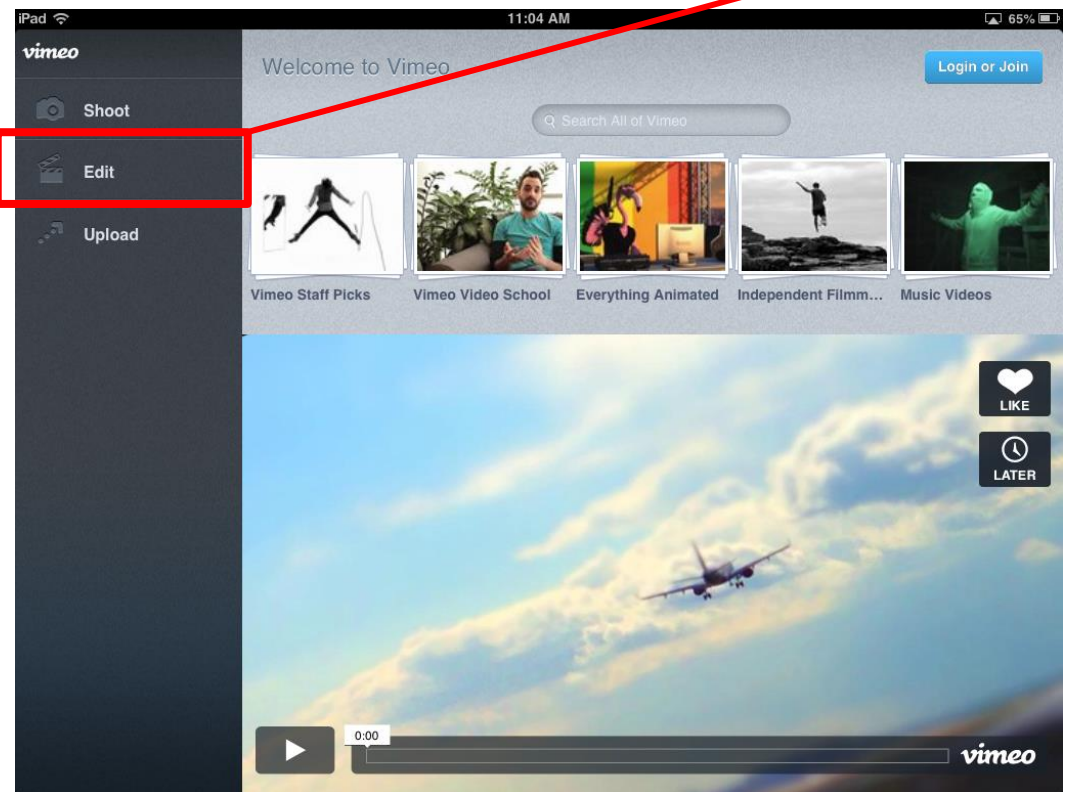
- The camera App must be enabled to record video.
- A Vimeo account is **NOT** needed to edit or save the video.

Download the App

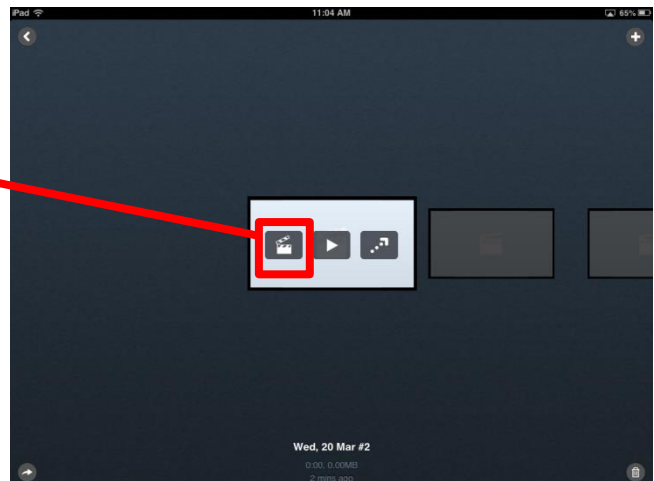
1. Follow the directions in the MDM Quickstart Guide to download the Vimeo App with MDM to the classroom cart of iPad.

Edit your video using Vimeo

1. When you launch the App you will see the splash screen for Vimeo. To begin editing a video tap on edit.



2. From this window tap on the clapboard to begin editing your video.

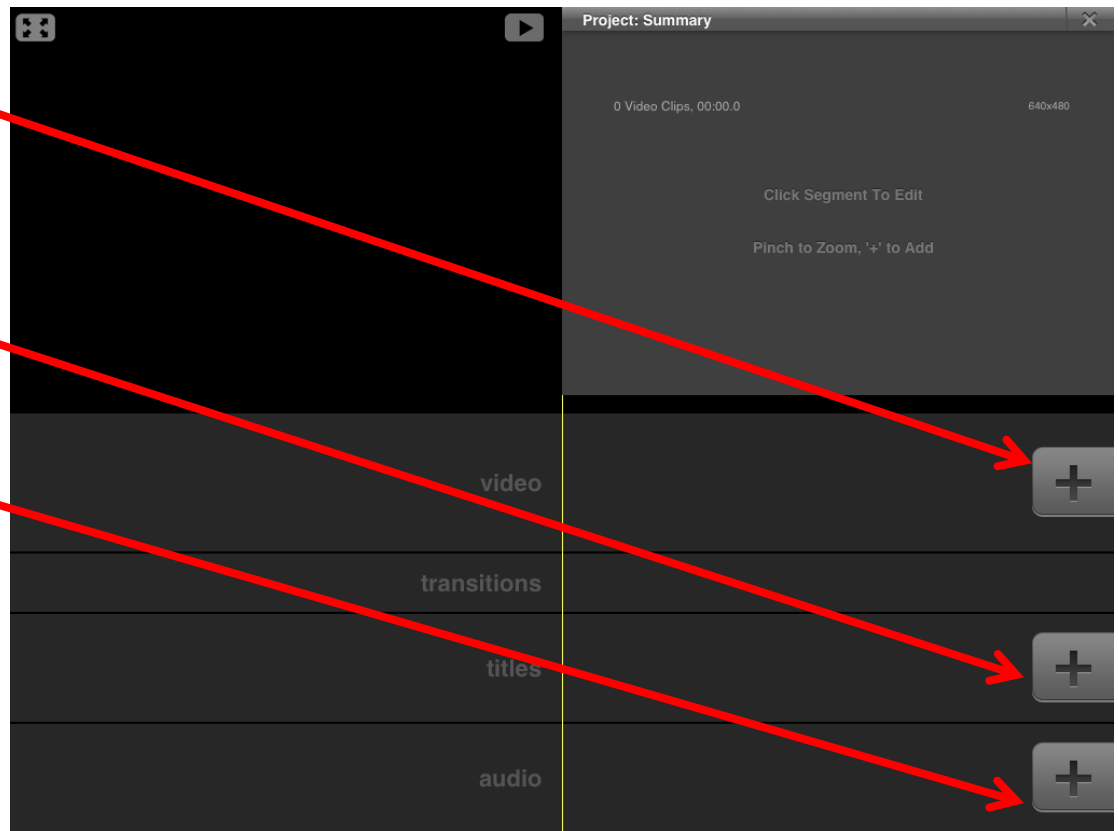

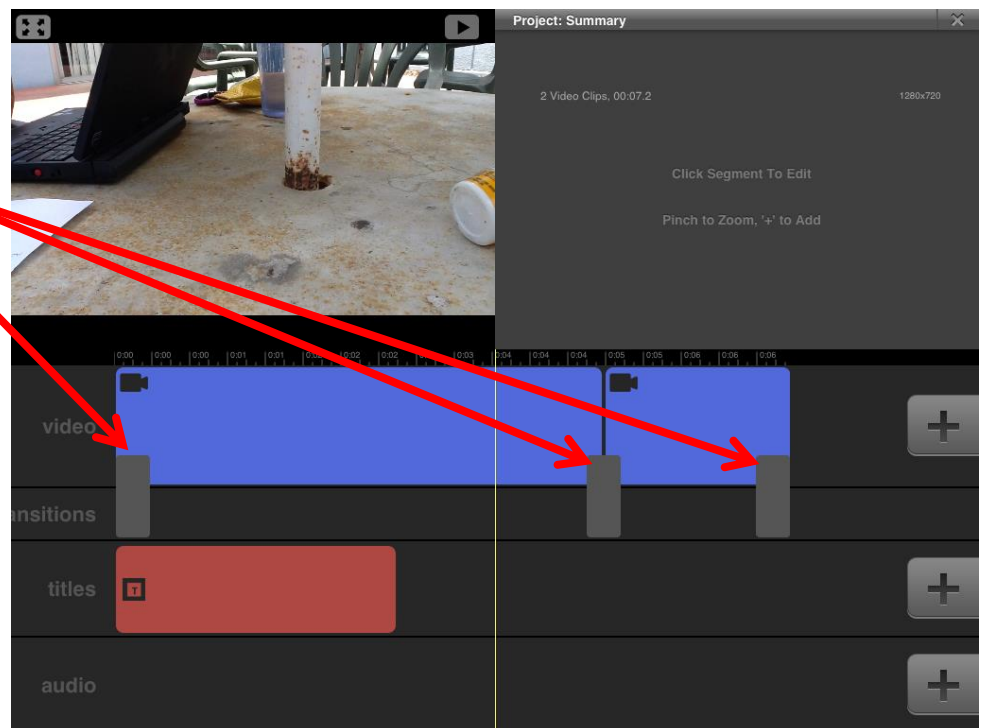
- To add video you have recorded to this project, tap on the plus in the video band.

- To add titles, tap on the plus in the title band.

- To add audio, tap on the plus in the audio band.



- Once you have added video, you will be able to add transitions. Tap on the grey rectangles to add transitions to your project.

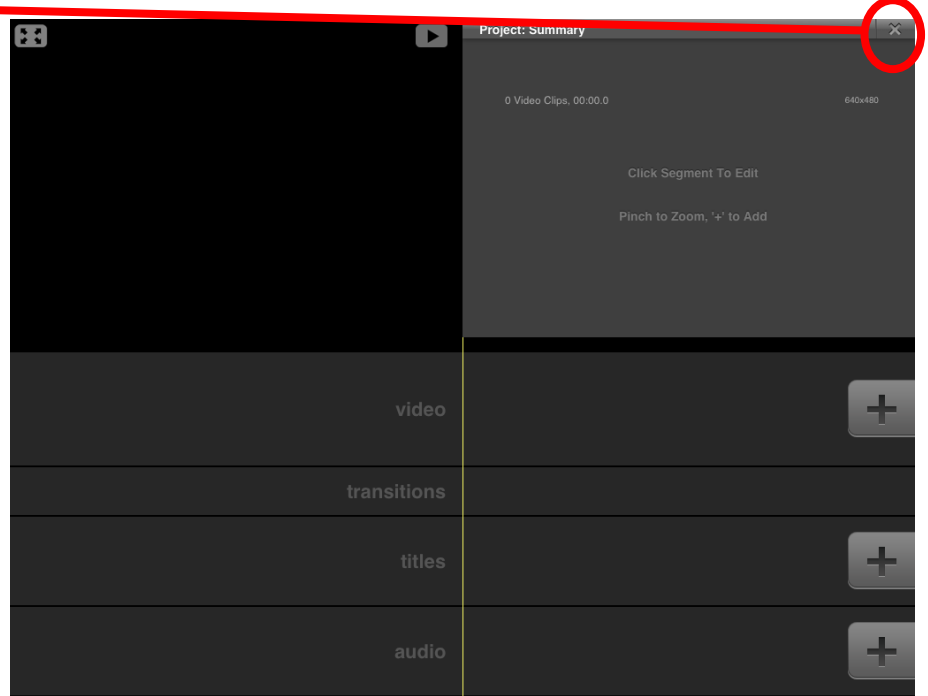




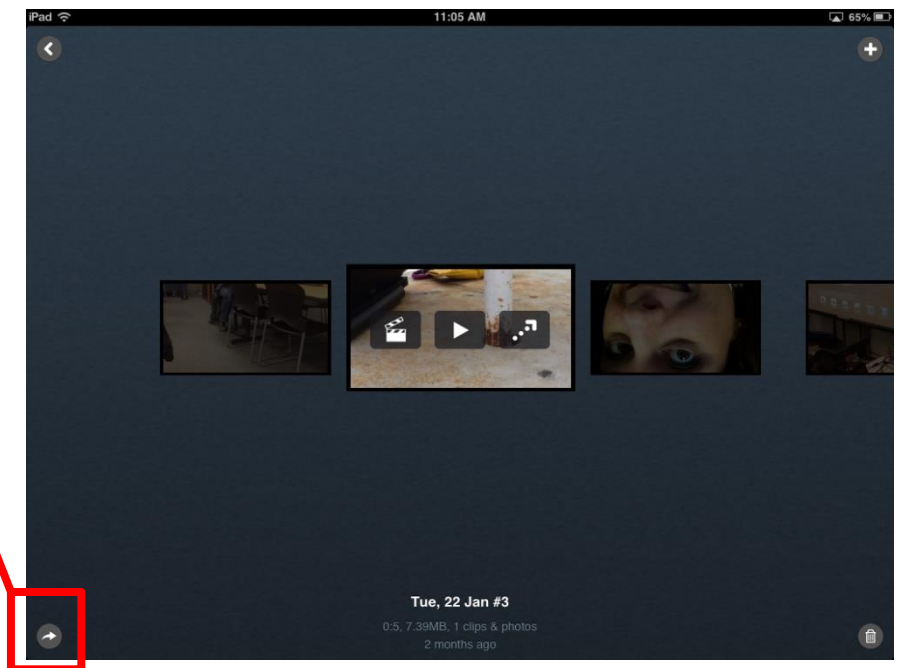

Save your video to the camera roll

1. Tap on the **X** in the upper right.



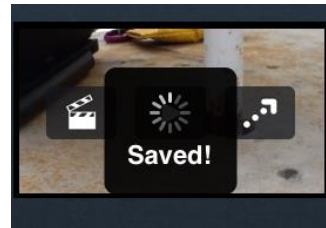
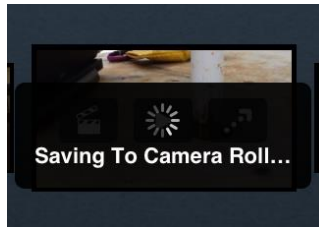
2. You will be taken to your projects screen. Tap on the curvy arrow in the bottom Left of the screen. This will render your project which saves it to the iPad Camera Roll.
