Look for these clues.

“The best title for this story...”



“What caused...?”

“Compare/contrast...”

## 3. Author and Me

Sometimes, the answer comes from clues in the book and your own ideas.

Look for these clues!

“The author implies...”



“This story suggests...”

“The character’s felt...”

## 4. On My Own

Sometimes, the answer comes from things you already know.

Look for these clues.

“Based on what you know...”

“In your opinion...”



“Think about someone who...”
