  - For men *dinner jackets*
- BBC now: style.: *smart casual*
  - Women: *smart skirt, blouse or trousers*
  - Men: *smart trousers, nice skirt, tie and jacket*
- Ukrainian dress codes:
  - Used to wear: *flashy provocative styles*
  - Now: *Subdued fashion and colors, a conservative style of dress*
  - Women: no strong *perfume*, plunging *cleavages* or pumped up *heels*, no *mini skirt*
  - Men: *trousers* and *suit sleeves* should be *the correct length* and they have to wear a *different outfit every day*
- Country where Western style was banned: *Zaire (Democratic Republic of Congo)*
