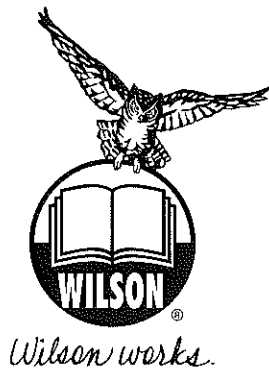

Closed Syllables (3 sounds)

- 1.1 **f, l, m, n, r, s** (initial) · **d, g, p, t** (final) · **a, i, o** (blending of 2 and 3 sounds)
- 1.2 **b, sh** · **u** · **h, j** · **c, k, ck** · **e** · **v, w, x, y, z** · **ch, th** · **qu, wh** (introduced gradually)
- 1.3 Practice with above sounds (**wish, chop, wet**)
- 1.4 Double consonants, **all** (**bill, kiss, call**)
- 1.5 **am, an** (**ham, fan**)
- 1.6 Adding suffix **-s** to closed syllable words with 3 sounds (**bugs, chills**)
