

The Polar bear is an endangered species

- The large front paws are paddle shaped and webbed providing enabling fast swimming. On the muscular hind legs the Polar bear can be a maximum height.
- The Sense of smell is the Polar bears in comparison with other predators trained exceptionally well. Also, hearing is very sensitive. So they feel for the thickness of the ice and hear water reflections to optimal to find starting points for the breaking up of water holes.
