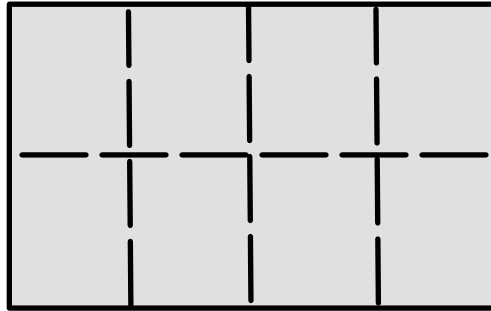
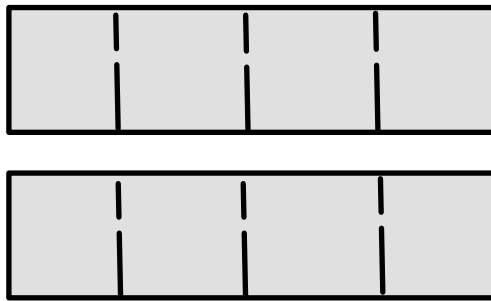


5. Concertina Book

One of the most versatile forms, folded like an accordion



1. Fold a piece of paper into eight sections.



2. Cut the paper in half horizontally.

3. Glue two ends together to make a long strip with 7 sections. *[May add more paper to create longer books.]*



4. Fan fold it. *(You can attach a hard cover if you wish to front and back, with a closure of ribbon, yarn or string.)*

5. Variations include cutting the sides and top edges, making openings, pop outs and adding origami features like the "cup" and "snake" sections. (pg. 11)
