

Autobiography Assignment

Send me an email via Firstclass about yourself that will help me get to know you as a person and as a math student. It should have two parts:

1. **Your personal autobiography.** Write about yourself and your interests. Describe a few of your activities and hobbies, talents and passions, values and commitments. What are the important things that you want me to know about you?
2. **Your mathematical autobiography.**
 - (a) Describe yourself as a math student. What aspects of math do you find easy and difficult?
 - (b) What have been your best and worst experiences related to math?
 - (c) What kinds of math class activities are good or bad for you?
 - (d) What do you like about math itself?
 - (e) And finally, what are your goals for this math class?

Please write honestly and informally (I'll be the only one reading these). This assignment is my first chance to learn about many of you, so it's important to just be yourself. I will not be grading your writing or judging your opinions in any way. If you'd prefer, feel free to write your autobiographies in Word and just attach them to the email message.

Important. When sending the e-mail to me, make sure the subject line is formatted as follows:

Lastname, Firstname - Autobiography Assignment
