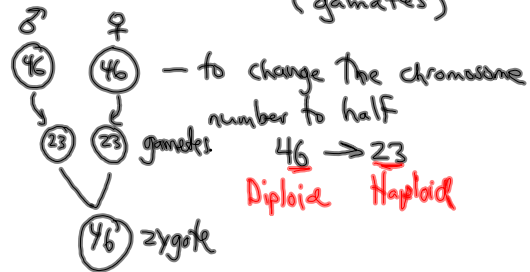
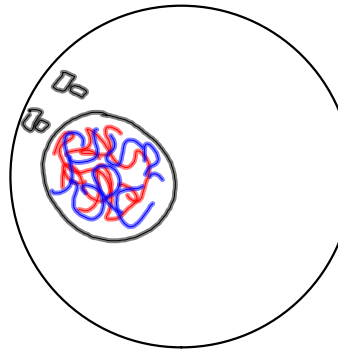

MEIOSIS — develop the sex cells (gametes)

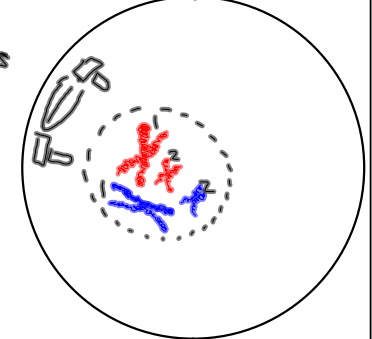


Interphase (46)



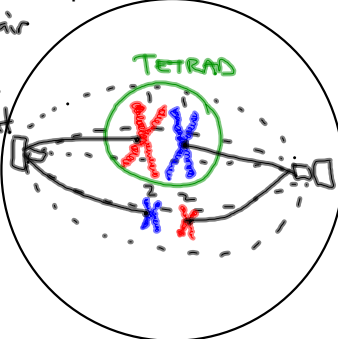
Prophase I (46)

- chromosomes condense

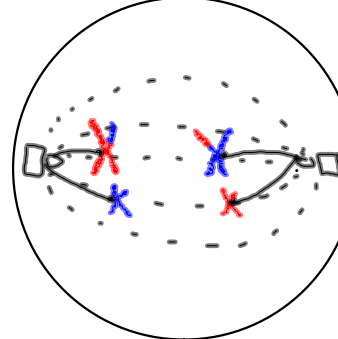


Metaphase I (46)
