**THE BROTHERS GRIMM**

**LEWIS CARROLL**

right, is the pen name for Charles Lutwidge Dodgson (1832-1898). In 1865 he wrote *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* to entertain a young friend.

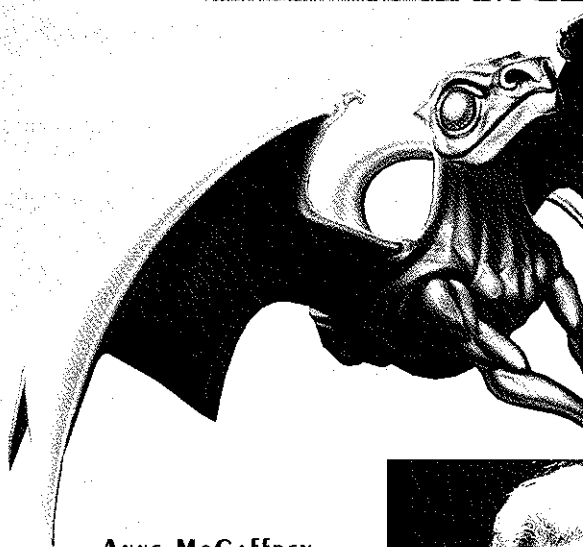


**J. R. R. Tolkien**

(1892-1973) right, British scholar and novelist. He created and illustrated an entire fantasy world for the characters in *The Hobbit* and his epic trilogy *The Lord of the Rings*.

**ALAN ALEXANDER MILNE**

(1882-1956) above. His son, Christopher Robin, pictured here, and his son's teddy bear were the inspiration for *Winnie-the-Pooh* published in 1926.

**ANNE McCaffrey**

(1926-) right. Dragons and their riders populate McCaffrey's imaginary planet of Pern. Their adventures are told in a series of fantasy novels.
